



LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE PRELIMINARY LEVEL OR ABOVE AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE, REINING AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDES. A NON-MEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, AGENT, COACH OR TRAINER AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS, REINING COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS UPON PAYMENT OF A \$30 NON-MEMBER REGISTRATION FEE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMEMTNS OF THIS RULE; 1) LEADLINE; 2) EXHIBITIONS; 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK TROT AND ACADEMY CLASSES (Academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES, 7) NRHA ENDORSED REINING COMPETITIONS; 8) OPPORTUNITY CLASSES; 9) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS WHO HAVE PROOF, IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION, 10) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION; AND 11) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES.

#### **HUNTER & EQUITATION CLASS SPECIFICATIONS**

**HUNTER COURSES:** Courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as brush, wall, in & out, oxer, post and rails, aiken, and panels. In some classes a mandatory line may restrict the area of the courtesy circle. This line will be indicated on the course diagram and physically in the ring by use of bushes, wood markers, or cones. **PRIZE MONEY:** Per HU112.3 – Prize money for all prize money classes and classics will be distributed 30%, 22%,

15%, 13%, 10%, 10%.

**AWARDS:** Ribbons 1-8 to be awarded in all "A" and "C" rated classes; 1-6 in all others. Champion and Reserve awarded to each division, using 10,6,4,2,1,1/2. Model points to count as ½.

All Hunter Divisions will be held in accordance with USEF Rules and Zone 5 Specifications. Hunter Sections will less than six entries will be combined.

**JUMPER COURSES:** Courses to consist of any combination of the following: brush, gates, oxers, post and rail, Liverpool, wall, panels, bank, and coops. Time allowed is based on 382 yards per minute unless otherwise noted.

**ORDER OF GO:** Check in order of go will be used except for Classics, where the order of go will be posted by 5pm the night prior.

**AWARDS:** Ribbons 1 – 6; Champion and Reserve Champion awarded in each section with three classes, using 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, ½. Prize Money is all Jumper Classics: 30%, 22%, 15%, 13%, 10%, 10%.

**ENTRY FEE:** \$35/class except for Classics.

**ADDITIONAL SPECS:** Ties for other than first place will be decided by the time taken in the first round. Formal attire requested for Classics.

#### **GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS**

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT US EQUESTRIAN RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

**Stabling:** Stall requests will be taken up to five days prior to start of show. All Stalls are \$110 and are located in the new barn adjacent to the new Indoor Arena. All Stalls come with doors; no initial bedding provided. Stalls will be limited and will be taken on a first come first serve basis. Stalls are available 12 noon Thursday and must be vacated by end of show on Sunday. A Grounds Fee of \$25 will be charge to each entry if a stall is not required. A one-night Stall Fee of \$50 is available for entries only showing on Sunday (Short Stirrup, Leadline, and Opportunity).

Entries: Entries are accepted on a first come first serve basis and will be accepted up to the start of the show. Once the show has started a late fee of \$25 may be assessed. Horses may not be schooled until a signed entry form has been turned in with the secretary. Only entries with the required USEF/USHJA membership numbers and a blank check to cover fees will be considered valid. Any participant showing in classes not entered may be subject to being charged double the entry fee required. If participants are not a member of the USEF and/or the USHJA the required non-member fees will be charged to each party in violation. All exhibitors in the Junior Hunter and classes restricted to ponies must present their measurement card prior to acceptance of entry into those classes; Amateurs must present their Amateur certification before their entry will be accepted into classes requiring amateur certification. Measurement will be at 5pm Friday and 7:45am Saturday for those entries requiring measurement.

**Fees:** A \$30 Operations fee will be added to each horse. New this year you will also be required to pay a \$2 per horse USHJA Zone Support Fee. USEF and Drug fee \$15.

**Refunds:** Participants having to scratch entirely from the show once the show has started will be refunded their entry fees only if a signed veterinarian's certificate is received in the show office by the official show veterinarian. Once stalls have been reserved they are non-refundable. Should management have to cancel classes/divisions/that cannot be re-scheduled due to inclement weather and/or any other emergency situation there may be no refunds on any and all fees.

Non-Showing Horses: A fee of \$100/horse will be charged for each non-showing horse.

Motorized Vehicles: Per GR 1301.7 – Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on completion grounds. Minors with a valid temporary license may operate vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance to Rule 6. Wheelchair and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. Prize Money: Per GR 1210.6: If required by management, premiums of the competition will be paid to all competitors that have provided Social Security numbers, Federal ID numbers or Tax Identification numbers to the competition secretary. It is the sole responsibility of the competitor to provide the competition secretary with accurate payee information, including Social Security number, Federal ID number, or Tax Identification number, payee name and address. The above mentioned premiums may be paid at checkout but no later than 30 days after the last day of the competition provide all above requirements have been met.

**Leash Law:** All dogs must be on a leash when on show grounds. Any owner whose dog interrupts a competitor's round will be subject to the payment of the class interrupted.

**Poling:** Manual poling and use of bamboo offsets are prohibited at all times while on show grounds. Exhibitors found in violation will forfeit all entry fees for that showing day or day afterwards and may be excluded from showing for 24 hours upon any incident recorded with Management and the USEF Steward.

**Medical Waste:** Due to Federal Regulations, all medical waste must be separated. Receptacles (sharps containers) are provided for hypodermic needle waste. Failure to use them will be result in a \$100 fine per needle found. PLEASE DO NOT MIX NEEDLES WITH THE MANURE OR TRASH!

**Helmets:** Per GR 801.2 – It is compulsory for riders in all Hunter, Jumper and Hunt Seat Equitation classes where jumping is required, when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds, and when riding in the show rings to wear a properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. Helmets must be properly fitted with harness secured. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

**Horse Identification:** All horses competing in US Equestrian Federation recognized competitions (except those activities enumerated in Art. 1401-6) must be properly identified and must obtain a USHJA Registration. Anyone knowingly applying for a duplicate number for an individual horse may be subject to disciplinary action.

**Management:** Management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, and to cancel any entry, disqualify exhibitor(s), prohibit exhibition of entries and cancel awards of prizes without claims for damages. Divisions may combine or cancel if insufficient entries warrant; Management reserves the right to amend the Tentative Time Schedule as it deems necessary. Neither the Kentucky Horse Park, Country Heir Horse Shows, Frankie Stark, Dean Rheinheimer, nor Alexandra Rheinheimer will be responsible in any way for loss or damage, to any persons, animals, or property or equipment that may be caused by any horse or pony entered by Exhibitor or due to the carelessness or negligence of the person or persons in charge of such horse or pony or their subordinates. This shall be the condition of entry to the show and show grounds.

Championship & Reserve: Hunters & Equitation: Champion and Reserve Champion title will be awarded to two of the four horses acquiring the most points over fences in each applicable section. In addition to these points, only these four horses will receive full points for under saddle classes. Points to determine awards are as follows: 10,6,4,2,1,1/2. Model points are to count ½. Jumpers: Champion and Reserve Champion title will be awarded to the two horses which have acquired the most points in each Jumper section that offers 3 or more classes/section. In the event of a tie, the award will be made jointly. Prize Money awarded in each jumper section will count towards their respective USEF Horse of the Year Awards. Points to determine awards are as follows: 10,6,4,2,1,1/2.

**Back Numbers:** A signature is required on each entry blank for each rider that rides that horse. Anyone found riding an entry while displaying a back number assigned to others without first having the new rider's signature attached to that entry will be considered in noncompliance. This signature is the sole responsibility of the rider. Riders found not in good standing will be subject to the penalty of the Federation as stated in GR908.3 and may be subject to disqualification and/or expulsion.

**Health Papers:** Current Coggins (taken with the past 12 months) and 30 Day Health Certificate must be presented at the entrance to the Horse Park in order to gain entry to the Park.

**Schooling:** Open Schooling Over Fences to take place on Thursday, from 1pm – 7pm; Flatting is available 6:30 – 7:30 each morning of competition.

Rings: The warm-up ring measures 72X160 and the show arena is 309X147 both with sand/clay mix.

#### **Federation Entry Agreement**

By entering an Equestrian-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation (the Federation) and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or likeness of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State.

#### **2010 Zone 5 Specifications**

In accordance with GR 1111.4: Canada, IA, WI, MO, TN, VA, WV, PA are contiguous states.

#### **Adult Amateur Hunter:**

To be ridden by Amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior Exhibitors. Riders may not compete in any other classes at the same competition where fences exceed 3'3", except the Adult Amateur Jumper and Amateur Owner Hunter. Any rider showing in the Amateur Owner Hunter division may compete 1 different horse in the Adult Amateur Hunter division and must own or have an USEF registered lease of said horse. Fences to be set between 2'9" to 3'; spreads not to exceed fence height. Ponies may be shown by Adults, suitability to count. Entries need not be jogged for soundness. An unrestricted Children's/Adult Hunter division may be offered and be open to all Amateurs and Juniors and fences are not to exceed 3'3".

#### **Children's Hunter:**

Open to horses and ponies. To be ridden by a Junior Exhibitor. Neither horses nor riders may cross enter into the Junior Hunter section at the same show. Riders may not cross enter into any classes in which fences exceed 3'3" at the same show, except Medal classes, age group equitation classes and Children's Jumper classes. Ponies may not compete in the Children's section if also entered in the pony division at the same show. Fence heights 2'9" to 3'; spreads not to exceed fence heights. Entries need not be jogged for soundness. An unrestricted Children's/Adult Hunter division may be offered and be open to all Amateurs and Juniors and fences are not to exceed 3'3".

#### **Children's Hunter Pony:**

Open to ponies ridden by a Junior Exhibitor. Riders may not cross enter into any classes in which fences exceed 3'3" at the same show, except Medal classes, age group equitation classes and Children's Jumper classes. Ponies may not compete in the Children's section if also entered in the pony division at the same show. The combination pony/rider is not eligible for USEF rated classes at the same show. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, and suitability as a Children's Hunter Pony. To be offered at two heights: fences 2' for small and medium and 2'6" for large ponies; spreads not to exceed height of fence. Ponies need not be jogged for soundness. No in and outs. Zone award will be presented annually as two sections: small/medium and large.

#### Children's Jumper:

Open to horses and ponies. To be ridden by a Junior exhibitor. Horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any Junior Jumper section at the same show. Riders may cross enter into Low Junior Jumper section if offered on a different horse at the same show. Riders may not compete above 1.30m (4'3") in any open class at the same show. Sections may be divided by age of rider or by horse/pony and may also be combined with the Adult Amateur Jumper section, if so stated in the prize list. Fences to be set at 3'6" or 1.10m; however shows may offer one class at 1.15m (3'9").

#### **Adult Amateur Jumpers:**

Open to horses and ponies to be ridden by exhibitors who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior Exhibitors. All exhibitors must be Amateurs in accordance with GR1306 and must show USEF Amateur certification. Horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any Amateur Owner Jumper section at the same show. Riders may cross enter into the Low Amateur Owner Jumper section if offered on a different horse at the same show. Riders may not compete above 1.30m (4'3") in any open class at the same show. Sections may be divided by age of rider or by horse/pony and may be combined with the Children's Jumper section, if so stated in the prize list. Fences to be set at 3'6" or 1.10m; however shows may offer one class at 1.15m (3'9").

#### **Pre-Green Hunter**

A Pre-Green Hunter is a horse of any age in its first or second year of showing over 3' to 3'3" fences at USEF Regular Member or Canadian Equestrian Federation or any national or international competition. Fences not to exceed 3'3". A 3' section must be offered and a 3'3" section may be offered. Horses may only compete in one height section at a show but may alternate from one show to another. Once a horse has shown 3'6" he is not eligible to compete in the Pre-Green Hunter division, regardless of age. Exception: green reinstatements. **Pre-Green may not be reinstated.** There will be two annual awards for the Pre-Green division: 3' and 3'3".
